Entry Requirements

Entry fee and application form must be submitted prior to April 22.

All entries must include digital images for identification/assessment.

Digital images are due before entry will be accepted.

Do not photograph images under glass or in frames.

Images may be uploaded to our website via online registration form or delivered to our office on CD or flash drive.

Artwork Specifications

2D work cannot exceed 46" in width or height.

2D work must be wired for hanging.

3D work must have a solid base and be accompanied by a study pedestal.

We will not accept...

fragile work.
work requiring special lighting or installation.
work that is too large or heavy.
work that is too difficult to hang.

Sales and Reproduction

A price needs to be provided for all artwork. If not for sale, please indicate NFS with a value estimate.

Prices should include a 15% commission for AAAC.
